THINGS TO REMEMBER

- We would appreciate if you could send in one box of tissues per term.

• Parents do not need to send anything into the Nursery School if it is their child's birthday. We will supply a cake and take photographs etc.

• Please remember that, at this time of year, Head Lice can be very prevalent. Try to check your child's head at least once a week. If you should find any head lice then please inform the school immediately.
