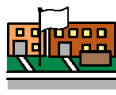
**NURSERY SCHOOL ENROLMENT**



Any child who is born between 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2019 and 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020 is eligible to apply for a Nursery School place. Application forms must be completed online at [www.eani.org.uk](http://www.eani.org.uk) for all children seeking admission in September 2023. Forms must be submitted online by 12 noon on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2023. If you are receiving Income Support or Universal Credit a Benefit Verification form must be stamped by the Social Security Office and returned to the school by 12 noon on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2020.

Open mornings are being held in the Nursery School on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> January from 9.00am to 10.00am

**PRIMARY SCHOOL ENROLMENT**



Any child who is currently attending the Nursery School, and is 4 on or before 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019, should be enrolled in the Primary School of your choice by the 27<sup>th</sup> January 2023 (12 noon). Applications must be completed online.
