SNACKS/DINNERS

Please have snack/dinner money in an envelope with the child's name marked on it.

Snack/dinner money should be paid on a Monday morning.

Snack £3.00 per week

Dinners £2.50 per day = £12.50 per week

Total £15.50 per week

Just to remind parents that those who are on working tax credit can claim for free dinners.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Sweatshirts and coats need to be clearly marked with your child's name.
- Children should be wearing trainers or shoes with Velcro fastenings - no laces please
- Jewellery/earrings are not allowed as they can be dangerous for the children. Small stud earrings will be allowed.
- We would appreciate if you could send in one box of tissues per term.
- Parents do not need to send anything into the Nursery School if it is their child's birthday. We will supply a cake and take photographs etc.
- Please remember that, at this time of year, Head Lice can be very prevalent. Try to check your child's head at least once a week. If you should find any head lice then please inform the school immediately.
